We'll continue building that momentum with the **Vermont Changemakers Summit** on April 11 and our **Lieutenant Governor candidate forum** in Rutland on April 13.

During Earth Week, on April 21st at 6:00 PM, we'll be hosting a **screening of *The Plastic Detox*** at the **Savoy Theater in Montpelier**. We'll have a discussion immediately following with legislative leaders and experts on the problem with plastics and what we can do about it.



On the litigation front, we joined the Vermont Attorney General's Office and other allies in federal court on March 30 to oppose lawsuits filed by the Trump administration, 24 Republican-led states, Big Oil, and the US Chamber of Commerce trying to kill Vermont's landmark Climate Superfund law. We'll be back in federal court later in April as intervenors in a case to defend Secretary of State Sarah Copeland Hanzas as she seeks to protect sensitive voter information from getting into the hands of the Trump administration.
